Grant Guidelines

- **1.** Only nonprofit organizations will be considered.
- 2. Funding will be given to organizations/projects benefiting many.
- **3.** Only organizations located in the following communities will be considered for funding: Beverly, Danvers, Manchester, Middleton, Peabody, Salem, Topsfield, Wenham.
- 4. Applications supporting groups or events that openly discriminate against others will not be reviewed or funded.
- 5. Funds are intended to meet the needs of a specific project that may go unfunded without the assistance of CST.
- 6. Funds are not intended to be used for ongoing projects that are also funded by other organizations or for operational expenses.

Frequently Asked Questions

:: Is my school eligible for CDC funding?

Yes, all nonprofit organizations in our local community are eligible, including schools.

:: Can funding be used to pay staff or stipends?

No, this funding is meant to be a charitable contribution and we encourage all active participants to donate their time accordingly.

:: How much funding should I request?

While projects vary tremendously, we generally fund projects ranging from hundreds to a few thousand dollars. We strongly recommend itemizing your funding request and may partially fund projects.

:: Are these grants competitive?

Yes, with dozens of nonprofit organizations in our local community, funding can be competitive. Well-written grant applications, including funds itemization, a description of community impact, and clear goals, have the greatest likelihood of being funded.

:: Can my organization be funded more than once?

Yes, each organization is eligible to apply annually for funding.
